From the Principal's Desk

FACTION ATHLETICS CARNIVAL NEWS

Today we enjoyed some fabulous weather for the Long Jump and Throws events for selected students in Years 4-6. Many of the events were closely and keenly contested. Congratulations to all who participated and gave their all for their faction.

The Faction Carnival will take place next Friday, 4 September for students in Years 1-6. This will follow a very similar format to previous years. Once again physical distancing requirements will mean that there will be protocols put in place for parents attending, where they can sit and how they interact with students.

This year our K-PP students will have the opportunity to participate in their own mini-athletics carnival early in Term 4. This carnival will have a focus on age-specific activities and games suited to K-PP.

INTERSCHOOL ATHLETICS CARNIVAL

The Interschool carnival which is scheduled across two days on the 21 and 23 September here at Dalmain PS will go ahead, but will have significant modifications around parent and community attendance. With six schools participating, managing the expected large numbers of students, staff, parents and community members in-line with current Covid-19 restrictions is difficult. Therefore, it is necessary to put in place guidelines to address this, which effectively means reducing parent/community numbers attending. This will mean that for all participating schools, only parents of students in Year 6 will be able to attend on either of these two days. While this is not a measure that all schools involved want to put in place, it is a necessary one in our current circumstances. The other options are to have no spectators at all or as some schools have done not hold the carnival. While it will be very different, I am sure that all students participating will enjoy the experience and the opportunity to represent their school.

Congratulations to all students who were awarded a merit certificate at yesterday's assembly. See inside for details. Our next merit awards assembly will be held on 10 September.

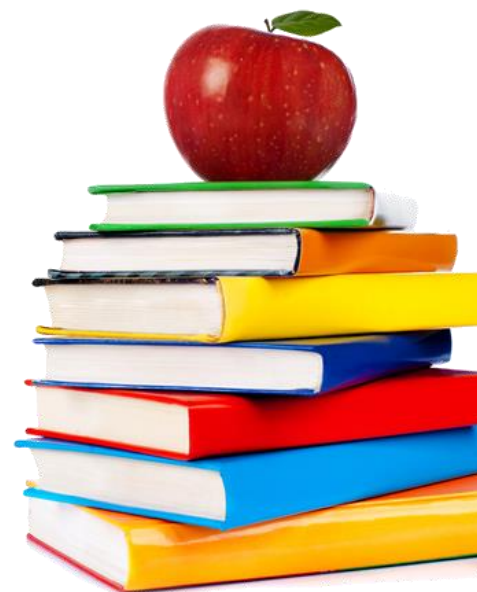
SCHOOL BOARD MEETING

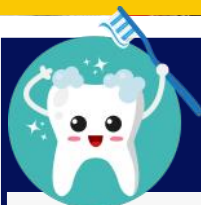
