MATHS PAVING DESIGNS

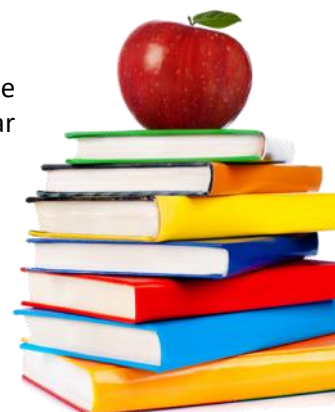
Last Friday evening the paving designs that are scattered around our quadrangle areas were completed. They have certainly added another element to our playground areas and I am sure that students will enjoy using them.

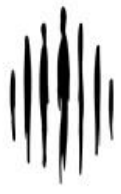
