From the Principal's Desk

Dear Parents and Community Members,

Welcome back to another term with numerous events planned and I'm sure some further highlights for our students. A copy of the term planner has already been forwarded home with students last term. An electronic copy of this planner is also available via our school website and the School Star app.

KINDERGARTEN/PRE-PRIMARY SPORTS DAY

This year our Kindergarten and Pre-primary students will have the opportunity to participate in their own mini-athletics carnival. This carnival will have a focus on age-specific activities and games suited to their year level. The emphasis will be on students having fun, joining in and demonstrating their skills. Parents are invited along to join in with this event which will be held out on our school oval from 9.00 – 11.00am Friday, 30 October.

YEAR 6 STUDENTS

This term will be an exciting one for our Year 6 students with camp as well as graduation planned. The camp will take place at Woodman Point Camp School from 11-13 November while graduation activities will be held on Thursday, 10 December. A Graduation Assembly will be held in the morning followed by a morning tea for students and parents. 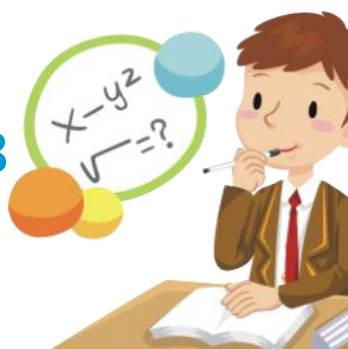

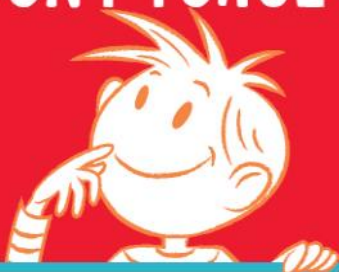
