ASSEMBLY

The final merit awards assembly for this year was held yesterday morning in the undercover area. Once again, it was pleasing to note the many varied and positive comments that students received on their awards from teachers. My congratulations to all students receiving certificates for their efforts. This assembly was also made even more significant with two additional presentations being made.

The first being the presentation of a Robin Bromley Visionary Grant to Canteen Manager Barbie Connick to assist with the continuing management of our school canteen by Leanne Irwin from the Western Australian School Canteen Association (WASCA) and Ash Ahluwalia from Brownes. Mrs Connick submitted a high quality application which was successful in obtaining the WASCA grant. Congratulations to Barbie on receiving this grant which also provides well deserved recognition for the way in which our canteen operates.

SCHOOL BOARD MEETING

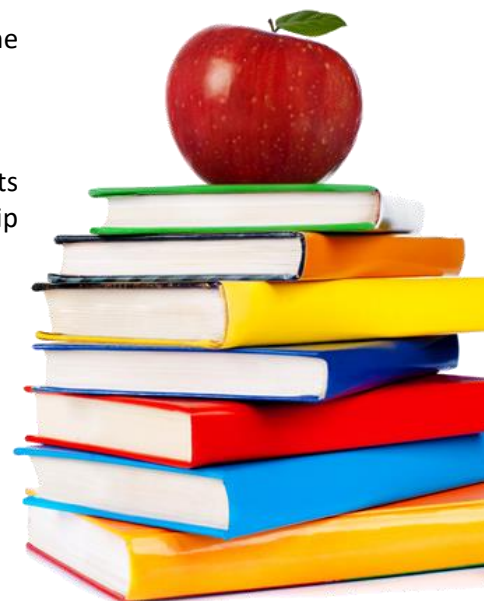
The final meeting for this year will be held next Thursday, 26 November in the staffroom commencing at 6.30pm.

Dalmain P&C are seeking an ambitious volunteer to fill the role of Canteen Coordinator. Candidates serve as an advocate for the canteen and liaise with members to help enhance this valuable P&C service. A successful coordinator will need to be willing to regularly attend P&C Meetings and assist the canteen manager with the following tasks:

Volunteer Recruitment

Posters for teaching areas have already been made & laminated. Coordinator could choose to use them, or find other means of encouraging parents to sign-up for canteen roster.

P&C Meetings

Coordinator will deliver a brief canteen report at the P&C meetings to keep members updated and connected with activities and management of canteen. Any relevant information generated in the meetings will then be relayed to the canteen manager.

Faction Athletics Carnival

Utilising the assistance available (P&C Members, Fundraising Committee, Canteen Manager & parent volunteers), the Coordinator assists with the canteen's involvement on this day.

Notifications

Ensure that carers, students and teaching staff remain updated on events and changes. In the case of illness or emergencies, the coordinator will notify the school and its student body of any canteen closures.



In Addition, the Coordinator would be encouraged, but not obligated to:

- Complete Traffic Light Training to comply with the Healthy Food & Drink Policy (training would be paid by P&C) On-line courses are available, and/or support is offered through the Western Australian School Canteen Association (WASCA) to host training at Dalmain.
- Attend WASCA development & general meetings with canteen manager.
- Become a "sounding board" to help bounce ideas and create menus with healthy food options, generate ideas for specials, promotions, themes and special occasions.
- Assist manager with end-of-year cleaning and stocktake.
