TOPS

Polo Shirt	Royal blue with gold panels on sleeves and gold piping on side. Embroidered Gold Dalmain Primary School Logo .
Zip Jacket	Royal blue with embroidered Dalmain Primary School Logo .
Faction Polo Shirt	Either Boomers (red), Eagles (blue), Sharks (green) with printed Dalmain Primary School Logo
Graduation Polo Shirt	Royal blue with white panels on sleeves and white piping on side. Embroidered white Dalmain Primary School Logo .
Winter Jacket	Royal blue with polo fleece lining with Dalmain Primary School embroidered Logo.

Logo embroidered/printed in contrasting colour on front left hand side of all items.

OTHER

Hat	Royal blue legionnaires sun cap - GOLD cap for Kindy. Hats are to be worn outside at all times under the "No hat, No play" policy.
Footwear	Trainers / Joggers (<i>Thongs, Crocs are not permitted</i>)
Jewellery	Watches, only earring studs can be worn.
Make Up	Make up and nail polish are not to be worn.
Hair	No large objects - ie: Flowery headbands etc. Shoulder length hair MUST be tied back.
NOTE:	All clothing and footwear must be clean and in appropriate condition for school use. Clothing with offensive slogans, messages, pictures or designs are not permitted. Denim is not part of the Dalmain Primary School Dress Code and should not be worn.

BACKGROUND

Dalmain Primary School was granted Independent Public School status in 2013. The newly elected school board, in response to a community survey, appointed a working party to investigate the practicalities of a new school uniform.

The colours royal blue and gold were still favoured by the community but the polo shirt, which was predominately gold, would now have a base colour of royal blue with a gold trim K-5 and a white trim in Year 6. These changes were adopted in 2014.

Students at Dalmain had worn bibs in their faction colours for sports days since the school opened in 1990. In 2014 the bibs were replaced with T-shirts in faction colours which are worn every Friday and on Faction Carnival days.
