



Dear Parents,

On Wednesday, 18th September, Dalmain Primary School choir will be participating in our Massed Concert. Here are some details regarding rehearsals and the concert itself.

Cluster Rehearsal

On Monday, 26th August, all choir students will be leaving school by bus at 11.20am for their first rehearsal at the Churchlands Senior High School auditorium. Students will have an early lunch at school at recess prior to leaving, and will only need to take a labelled bottle of water for the rehearsal. Students will need to be in school uniform on the day. The rehearsal finishes at 2pm, therefore we will be arriving back at school at approximately 2.30pm.

Day Rehearsal

On Monday, 16th September, all choir students will be travelling by bus again to the Churchlands Senior High School auditorium for our day rehearsal. Students will leave school by bus at 8.40am taking with them a snack for recess, their lunch and a labelled water bottle. Students will be given a break to have their snack mid-way through the rehearsal and they will be able to have a quick lunch break before leaving to come back to school. The rehearsal finishes at 1pm, and after having some lunch we envision arriving back at school by approximately 2pm. Students are again asked to make sure that they are in school uniform on the day.

The total cost for the bus trips is \$16.

Technical Rehearsal and Concert

On Wednesday, 18th September, students will need to arrive to the river side of the Perth Concert Hall by 5pm. Parents will be responsible for transport to the concert technical rehearsal on the concert evening. Students will need to arrive in their choir uniform which will be handed out to students the day before the concert.

All choir students are required to have long black trousers for the concert. The school will supply the choir shirt, vest and cummerbund and parents will be responsible for acquiring the black pants. Faded black jeans won't be ideal, nor thin black or navy leggings since the shirt will need to be tucked into the pants.

The timing of the concert night will be as follows:

Students will need to have a hearty early dinner before meeting at the Perth Concert Hall.

1. Arrive at the Perth Concert Hall meeting outside at the river side at 5pm.
2. The technical rehearsal begins at 5.45pm. Parents will not be able to view this rehearsal, however it would be a great time for parents and family to have some dinner before the concert. The tech rehearsal finishes at 7pm.
3. After the tech rehearsal, students will wait in the upstairs foyer ready for the concert. It will be close to this time the audience will be taking their seats.
4. The concert commences at 7.30pm and finishes at approximately 9pm.

5. Students will be led out into the inside upstairs foyer on the river side after the concert. The doors along this foyer will be labelled with schools' names indicating which door parents will be able to pick up their children.

Choir Uniform

As stated earlier, the students will be able to take their choir uniform home the day prior to the concert. Could you please assist with the uniform by making sure that your child has the following;

1. Black pants with the white shirt tucked in, blue vest, cummerbund and black shoes.
2. All long hair needs to be tied up neatly with no long loose bits around the face if possible. Students need to make sure that the hair elastic is either black or brown and they may use glitter hairspray if they like.
3. We've been told that students are not to wear noticeable jewellery, or big hair bands that might stand out.
4. Students will be able to bring with them on the night a labelled water bottle.

I feel very proud of our choir students and I'm very much looking forward to watching them perform in a massed choir at such a prestigious venue. Please feel free to speak to me at school if you have any further queries regarding the concert. Could parents please ensure that the following permission slip, payment of \$16 and medical information is returned to school by Thursday, 22nd August.
